**Open Show – 18<sup>th</sup> February 2006 – Judge Linda McGregor**

It was an honour and a pleasure to judge the Open show at The Bull Terrier Trophy Show weekend. The quality of the entry (123) was of a very high standard, with the dogs equalling the bitches for a change, this must bode well for the breed. The popularity of the show seems to grow every year. As well as overseas visitors coming to see the show, we also have a number of overseas exhibits.

#### **Class 1 Puppy Dog – 8 entries (2 abs)**

- 1) Mill's Bilboen Locked and Loaded at Marshelsea – Heavyweight solid red – nicely filled head with good profile and expression, correct mouth. Could use his ears better. Strong well muscled body, straight front, short back, good bend of stifle. Moved well. Best Puppy Dog.
- 2) Chant's Battleton El Conquistador – br/w with good arc to head, correct mouth, nice length of neck, shapely body, still needs to mature all through, moved fairly well.
- 3) Monahan's Kellouacy Funky Budda

#### **Class 2 Junior Dog – 11 entries (4 abs)**

- 1) Westwoods' Tulsadoom Isakabuli – Powerful, cobby white dog, wicked eye, tremendous head, well filled with very deep muzzle. Correct mouth. Lovely reach of neck, deep chest good spring of rib, good bend of stifle, well put together and exudes in bone and substance. Excellent mover. A very impressive dog, did all his handler asked of him and more. A bright star for the future. BIS
- 2) White's Stockleyview Dark Destiny- Big upstanding tri coloured dog. Lovely sweeping profile, correct mouth, strong, shapely body. Excellent mover. Best class of the day with number 3 pushing hard.
- 3) Wannop's Charishalee White Storm.

#### **Class 3 Maiden Dog – 6 entries (4 abs)**

- 1) Stubbs's Tyeban Groundpower - First class bl/br/w, powerful head, being well filled and turned, correct mouth. Heavyweight yet still typy, decent front, short back, good bend of stifle. Excellent mover. Pushed hard for best coloured.
- 2) Welsby's Sherrywells Red Dragon – Smart r/w with good profile, correct mouth, shapely body, slightly longer in back than 1. Moved fairly well but close behind.

#### **Class 4 Novice Dog – 7 entries (2abs)**

- 1) Foster's Bilboen Latin Lover – Compact r/w, strong head with nice profile, correct mouth. Straight front, short back, good topline and bend of stifle. Mature in body. Moved well behind.
- 2) Dajan Lord of the Ring – Handsome r/w with lovely profile, correct mouth, good reach of neck, shapely body, but still needs to mature. In very good condition, movement hard to assess.

#### **Class 5 Post Graduate Dog – 6 entries (4 abs)**

- 1) Hearne & Singleton's Warbonnet Excell – Quality white dog with wicked eye, ears could be better placed. Well filled head with clean profile, correct mouth. Nice bone, but stands a bit wide in front. Deep chest, short back, moved a little close in front, but well behind.
- 2) Haase's Bavazuela Ingermar Joh – Compact white dog, strong head with very good expression, slight mouth fault. Mature in body with deep chest and good spring of ribs, correct topline and strong quarters. Moved fairly well.

#### **Class 6 Limit Dog – 4 entries (1 abs)**

- 1) Hall's Cwmdulais Marshelsea Dai Another Day – Handsome white dog. Very strong head with clean profile, lovely expression. Correct mouth. Decent front, well balanced, good bend of stifle. Moved fairly well.
- 2) Hind & Fowler's Mitzstaff Dimond Gezar – Mature white dog, nicely filled head with good profile. Correct mouth. Straight front and nicely made all through. Moved close behind.
- 3) Booth's Clive of Stafford

#### **Class 7 Open dog – 7 entries (1 abs)**

- 1) Sansom's Ch. Dajan King of the Road - Striking bl/br/w. Strong, powerful head with lovely profile, very deceptive when viewed from different sides. Slight mouth fault. Straight front, very compact, good spring of ribs, deep chest, good angulation and really well made all through. Excellent mover, shown in first class condition. Best Coloured in Show.
- 2) Smalley's Carbon Copy – Cobby bl/br/w. Very good head with excellent profile. Good mouth. Correct topline, short back, not so good angulation as 1. Moves close behind.
- 1) van Eden's Superbowl's Collierboy.

#### **Class 8 Puppy bitch – 12 entries (4)**

- 1) Probert's Million Dollar Baby at Llanwenarth – Quality white with beautiful

arc to head and completely filled with good turn down, ears could be better, correct mouth. Good reach of neck, decent front. Shapely body, lovely bend of stifle. Moved fairly well

- 2) Kersey's Khamra Wilhelmina – Very pretty br/w, well marked. Strong filled head, correct mouth. Straight front, good bone, compact and nicely made throughout. Moved well.
- 3) Holbrook's Iacia Dolly Daydream of Terissott

#### **Class 9 Junior Bitch – 13 entries (4)**

- 1) Clayton's Sherrywells Starflake at Praeclarus (Taf) – Feminine white, with beautifully balanced head, lovely arc, fill and turn down. Correct mouth. Shapely body and good topline. Moved fairly well.
- 2) Taylor's Biloen Lucifers Daughter at Ragnarok – Smart r/w. Strong filled head, correct mouth, good body lines, straight front, nice topline. Moved fairly well.
- 3) Mill's Terjo's Welsh Maid Among Marshelsea.

#### **Class 10 Maiden Bitch – 8 entries (3)**

- 1) Llewellyn's Bullypins Mayissa – Very pretty br/w. Beautiful head, completely filled and turned. Mouth fault. Compact with good front, short back, well made all through. Moved fairly well.
- 2) Taylor's Bilboen Sarays Challenge to Ragnarok – Upstanding tri coloured bitch. Decent front, nice topline and good bend of stifle. Moved fairly well.
- 3) Barritt's Romantacy Princess Rose

#### **Class 11 Novice Bitch – 12 entries (3 ab)**

- 1) McAllister's Kilacabar Kiss Kiss at Malican - Quality white. Very strong head without exaggeration, good expression. Straight front. Mature in body, with correct topline and well bent stifles. Moved fairly well.
- 2) Probert's Istonbull Kool Loving at Llanwenarth – Upstanding white, leaner than 1. Beautiful profile, with lovely turn down, correct mouth. Shapely body, A very promising youngster who just needs time to mature and tighten up. Moved fairly well. Best Puppy In Show.
- 3) Redmond's Terjo's Gun Street Girl of Barrog

#### **Class 12 Post Graduate Bitch – 11 entries**

- 1) Napier Tayla May – A top quality heavyweight. White with red ears. Very strong head with good round fill and nice turn. Excellent expression. Correct mouth. Deep chest, nicely balanced, very strong quarters. Moved close behind.

A powerful bitch who still retains her femininity. Best Bitch.

- 2) Smith's Helizar Ellusive Dream – Quality white bitch, lovely filled head with good turndown. Correct mouth. Straight front with neat feet, nice depth of chest good topline and quarters. Moved fairly well.
- 3) Toner's Trinity of Peace

### **Class 13 – Limit bitch – 13 entries (5 abs)**

- 1) Kilpatrick's Ryberdan Tidal Wave of Kilacabar – Quality white bitch with brindle ears. Strong head, well filled and good expression. Correct mouth. Turns her feet out at pasterns and feet could be neater. Nicely balanced all through. Moved adequately.
- 2) Leesley & Swan's Dajast Bedazzled at Lydsyll – A very eye catching bl/br/w. Strong head with good length and fill. Mouth fault. Decent front, good topline and well muscled quarters. Moved fairly well. Best Coloured Bitch
- 3) O'Neil's Wilet Bravespirit at Kholander

### **Class 14 – Open bitch – 7 entries**

- 1) Cooper's Bullyview Mask Maiden – Big upstanding white with eye patch and ear mark. Beautiful filled head with sweeping profile. Correct mouth. Would like smaller eye. Straight front, shapely body, decent bend of stifle. Movement could be better. Pressed hard for best bitch.
- 2) Redmond's Terjo's Maggie's Touch of Barrog – Quality white with black ears who did not make the most of herself. Strong, well filled head. Straight front, deep chest, correct topline, strong quarters. Moved close behind.
- 3) Alison & Roberts' Borsalino Chwaer Nikita at Teirwgywyn
